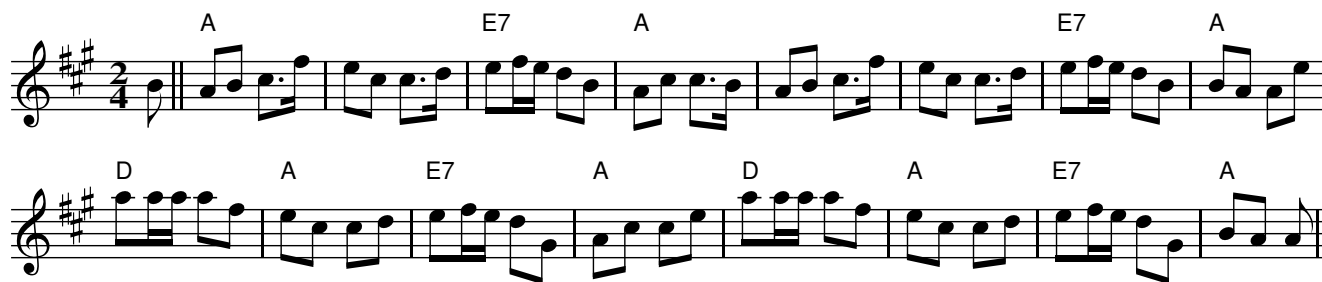


George Davis' Heel and Toe Polka
