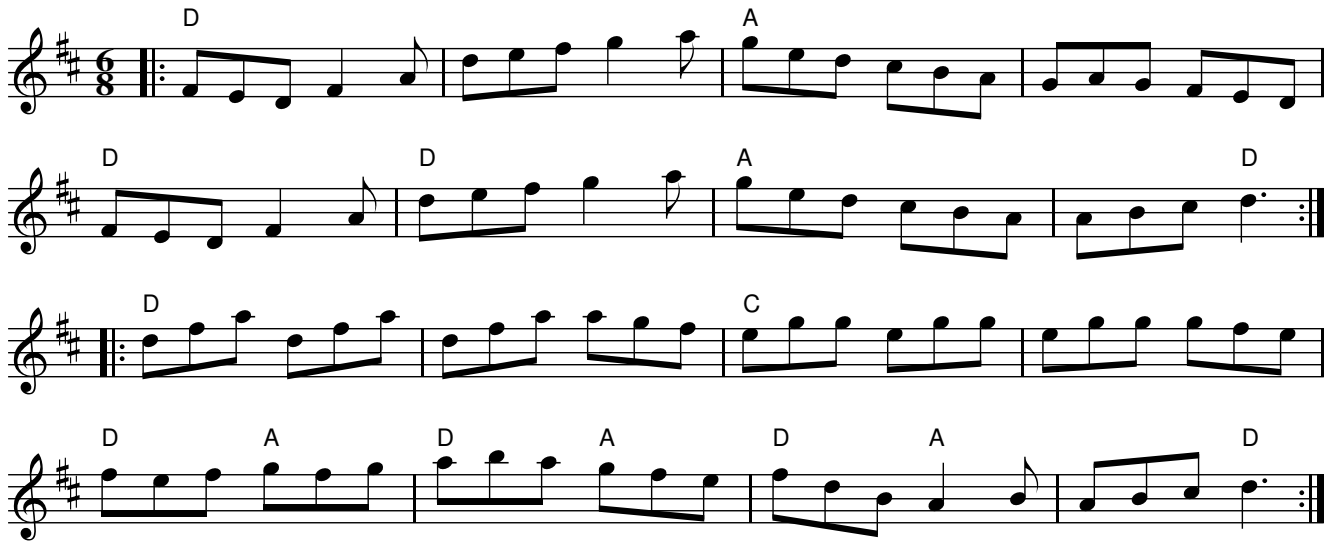

This is a version of an Irish jig called Kitty's Rambles which suits the 10-button melodeon. Collected in 1956, this is likely to be an older setting than that currently played in sessions.
